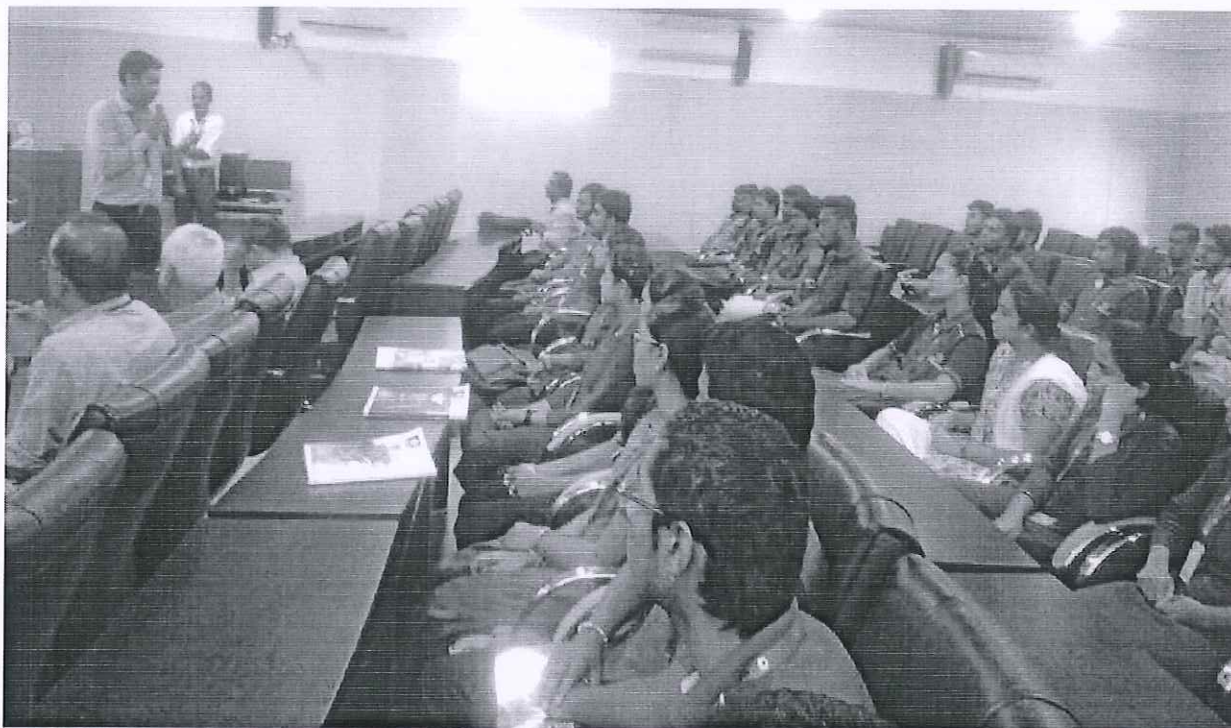
Following guidelines were given to the students

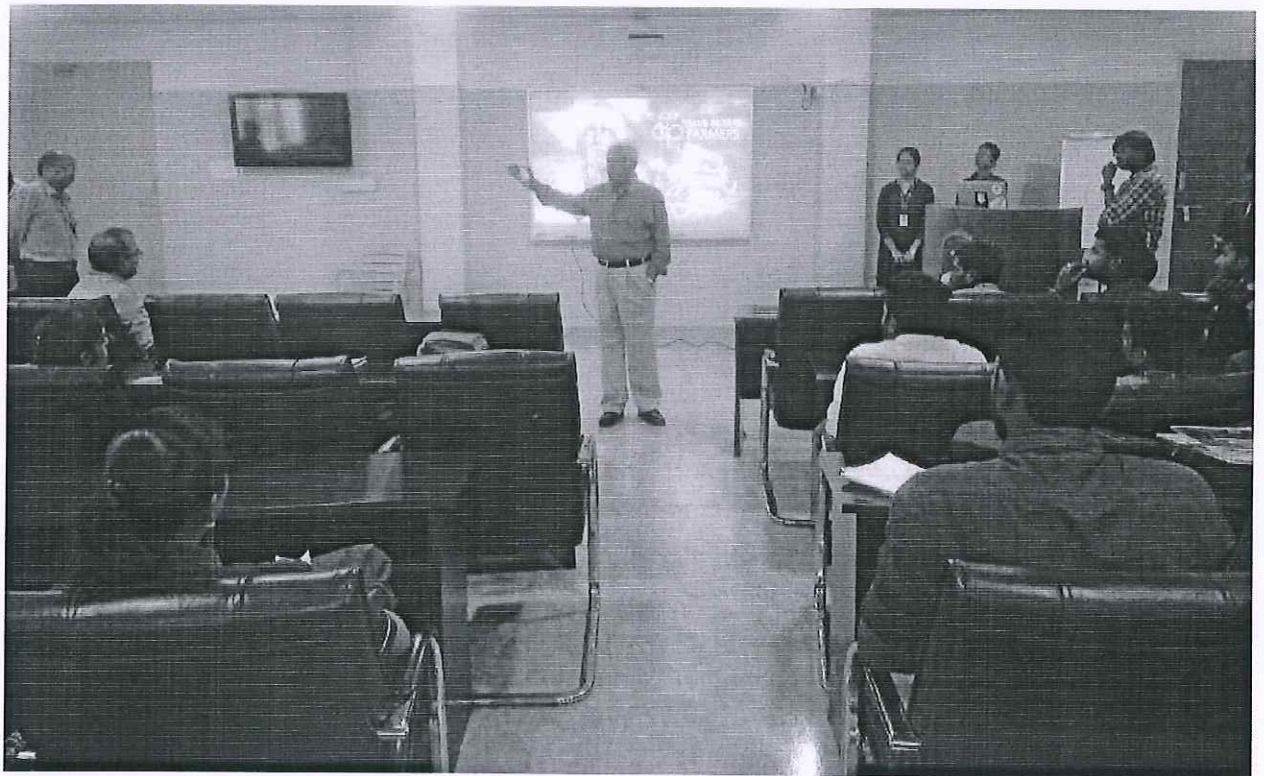
