Doctors from various medical specialties volunteered to treat the patients Dr. Maruthi, M.S, (Orthopedic Surgeon), Dr. M. Manjula, (Gynecologist), Dr. N. T. Muntaz, MDS (Dentist), Dr. S. Surendra, (Ophthalmologist), Dr. M. Radhakrishna Moorthy, M.S (Ophthalmologist), Dr. M. Srihari Naidu, M.D (General Surgeon) volunteered and extended their valuable Medical Services to the public of Chinna Ramapuram village. The patients were screened for hypertension, Diabetes, Hemoglobin levels and blood grouping was carried out by volunteer students of Sree Vidyanikethan College of Pharmacy. Patients were diagnosed by specialist doctors and were issued with appropriate prescriptions. Complaints regarding vision and other ophthalmic complications were screened and treated by an ophthalmologist. Prescribed drugs were dispensed free of cost.
