Minutes of the Meeting

Item 1 : The IQAC Coordinator welcomed the members and appraised on the activities envisaged since its previous meeting, till Twenty fifth meeting held on 07.09.2019 and the Chairperson requested the members to approve the minutes of its previous meeting. The following activities were taken up.

- Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College organized AP State Level ISTE Student Convention on "Current and Emerging Technologies" on 12th October 2019.
- Prof. V. Ramgopal Rao, Director, IIT, Delhi delivered a distinguished lecture on Innovation in Academic Institutions – a need for Multi-Disciplinary Research Approach on 15th November, 2019.
- ISTE Chapter of Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College has been identified as the Best Chapter of ISTE Andhra Pradesh Section based on the diversified activities organized for the year 2018 and Dr. M.S. Sujatha, Faculty Advisor, ISTE Chapter, SVEC received the award during the Inaugural function of 49th ISTE National Annual Faculty Convention held on 29th & 30th November 2019 at Siksha 'O' Anusandhan, Bhubaneswar, Odisha

- The Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College in association with IUCEE organized a five day workshop on "Effective Teaching (IIEECP-Phase-I)" from 9th to 13th December 2019. Dr. Claire Komives, Fulbright Nehru Scholar, Professor, Chemical and Materials Engineering, San Jose State University, California, USA was the Expert for the sessions.
- Dr. Nitin Kumar Tripathy, the Director, Special Programs, School of Engineering Technology, Asian Institute of Technology, Thailand visited SVEC, on 14.12.2019 and a meeting was held with the Honorable Chairman, SVET, and the Senior representatives of SVEC to discuss the Collaborations between the institutions.

Item 2 : The Chairperson, IQAC requested the Dean(Academics) for initiating the preparation of curriculum for upcoming SVEC-19 regulations considering the changes undertaken by the affiliating university, APSHE and the other statutory bodies.

Item 3 : Dr. DVS. Bhagavanulu, Director, SVEC suggested that the institution needs to plan aggressively in terms of research, encouraging the faculty members to apply for funded research projects, and further emphasis is to be given on the aspects of innovation.

He also suggested to apply to Support for Entrepreneurial and Managerial development of MSMEs through Incubators.

Item 4 : Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College, Tirupati has been identified the Best Chapter of ISTE Andhra Pradesh Section and in this direction members congratulated the ISTE team for its efforts. A student convention was held in this regard, it was also requested by the Chairman, IQAC to organize such events under different professional societies predominantly.

Item 5 : The Chairperson, IQAC and the external experts agreed to foster tie-ups or seek collaborations with International universities of repute for interactions in-terms of the student & the faculty exchange for the purpose of academic and research activities. It was also elaborated by the Director cum Advisor that the management is planning to depute four members from few departments to visit Queens University Belfast(QUB), UK.

Item 6 : The Director(Q&D) insisted that the departments should undergo mock visits for upcoming NBA accreditation visits to CSSE, ME, CE and EEE departments.

He also insisted that CSE, ECE and IT departments to be prepared for upcoming compliance visit for the same.

Item 7 : Progress of New NIVA module implementation was discussed in detail with the external members and a few suggestions were considered for futuristic implementation like report NOC generation, issuing bonafide certificates for the students and the other services.

The board discussed regarding the initiation of new demand driven programs in the areas of Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, Computer Science and Business Systems. It also discussed regarding the reduction/closure of few UG/PG programs which has very less demand.
