ETA (Electrical Technical Association) is a student's association started, run and maintained by students aiming at honing their inter- and intra-personal skills. It was started during the academic year 1997-98 and was the first of its kind.

The Electrical Technical Association holds the responsibility in enhancing technical knowledge in the field of Electrical Engineering, boosting the confidence levels of students, and inculcating morals and ethical values for wholesome development of oneself. This year, an overall of 15 events were conducted. A total of 498 students had participated and 46 students bagged prizes.

All the organized events helped to instil Communications skills, Analytical skills and Team Leadership skills among the students. In turn it helped organizers in improving their organizing skills. These events are conducted every year as a regular practice.
