### Minutes:

### 1. Action Taken Report on minutes of 9<sup>th</sup> BOS meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2018

The Chairperson BOS appraised the members the action taken on the minutes/ resolutions of 9th BOS meeting held on 29th May 2018. After deliberations the members ratified the report and the same is placed at Annexure - I.

### 2. Academic Calendars

The Chairman BOS presented the members the academic calendars for III and IV semester for the academic year 2019-'20. After deliberations and discussions the calendar is recommended for approval by AC and the same is placed at **Annexure-II**. As the admission dates are not finalized for I M. Tech. classes during the academic year 2019-'20, it is resolved to authorize the Chairman BOS to prepare academic calendar for I M. Tech. and to submit to the Chairman (Academic Council) for approval.

### 3. Vision and Mission of the Department, PEOs, POs & PSOs and Course Structure

The Chairman BOS has appraised the members the Vision & Mission of the Dept. which was already approved, for continuity. The Chairman BOS has presented the program Education Objectives, Program Outcomes, Program Specific Outcome and Course Structure. After deliberations and discussions, the members have ratified the PEOs, POs and PSOs. Certain changes are suggested by external members in the course structure which are placed at Annexure-III. The modified Course Structure is placed at Annexure-IV.

### 4. Administrative Setup

The Chairman BOS appraised the members that the syllabi is prepared in a decentralized way involving all the faculty members and keeping checks at multiple levels to ensure quality output. The members have appreciated the efforts of the Department and ratified the same after discussions. The ratified administrative setup is placed at Annexure-V.

### 5. Syllabi with Course Objectives & Course Outcomes, Lesson Plans and Model Question Papers

The Chairman BOS presented the draft syllabi prepared by the Department. After deliberations and discussions, the members have suggested certain improvements to the syllabi, lesson plans and question banks. It is resolved to authorize the Chairman BOS to adapt the improvements suggested, finalize the syllabi with lesson plan & question banks and submit to the Chairman (Academic Council) for further processing.

#### 6. Panel of Examiners for Question paper setting

After discussions, the board has suggested certain changes to the panels. It is resolved to authorize the Chairman BOS to make suggested changes to the panels and submit the same to the Chairman (Academic Council) for further processing.

#### 7. Teaching, Learning and Evaluation

The Chairperson BOS presented the teaching, learning and evaluation practices followed in the department. The members of BOS have appreciated the good practices followed by the department in the conduct of diagnostic and formative tests and remedial classes and suggested to continue the same. They also gave following suggestions for improvement.

- Faculty should continuously improve their teaching skills, communication skills, body language, board management etc.
- 2. Interaction among faculties handling the same subjects is required.
- 3. ICT techniques to be used liberally for teaching.
- 4. Recording the classes and listening at least once in a month will improve the teaching skills
- 5. The simulated results can be verified with Hardware results in lab courses.

 External members suggested to conduct class review meeting comprising of 6 students with two from top level two from bottom level and two from middle level to know the status of syllabus completion and to improve teaching and learning process.

#### 8. Research Activities

The Chairperson BOS has briefed the members about the research initiatives, such as thrust areas of research, research clusters and technical talks and research project sanctioned and submitted. The Chairperson BoS highlighted increase in number of appraised the members that the renowned researchers and academicians keep visiting the campus for guiding the faculty members in research activities. The members have appreciated the efforts of the college in providing such expert guidance. They also suggested to motivate more and more faculty members to publish papers in SCI-indexed and other reputed journals.

### 9. Faculty Development Activities

The Chairperson BOS has presented the members information on the research publications/ presentations by the faculty, books published, faculty incentives, qualification, up-gradation, FDPs attended, FDPs organized, and student feedback on faculty. The members have appreciated the efforts of the department and suggested to continue the same. They also suggested that more orientation towards Pedagogy is required and the faculty members should be trained to utilize Virtual Labs of AICTE model curriculum.
