  - Successfully implemented the autonomy with respect to syllabi and regulations (SVEC16 III MCA) for the academic year 2018-19.
  - As Resolved in 9<sup>th</sup> BOS Meeting, Model question papers and Panel of Examiners are prepared and submitted to the Principal and Chairman, Academic Council.
- 2. The External Members perused course structure, and suggested the following points are implemented successfully.

  - Suggested to replace Data science with Data Visualization and include Data Science as one unit in Data Analytics Course.
  - Advised to replace Python Programming with Web Programming and Web Programming with Python Programming.
  - Suggested to train the students by conducting Add-on course for Probability & Statistics using R tool.
  - Advised to include JAVA Script frameworks, Angular JS, JQuery, and VUE.JS in Web Programming Course.
  - Advised to move Open Elective (MOOC) course to VI Semester from V semester and Internship to V semester from VI semester.
  - Suggested to conduct Expert lectures for Deep Learning & Artificial Intelligence for students.

- It is resolved to authorize Chairperson, BOS for preparing List of **Panel of examiners** and Paper setters for MCA I, II and III years within 15 days after the commencement of Class Work in each semester and submit to the Principal & Chairman, Academic Council.
