- ii) The College shall establish Research Development and Innovation Centre for encouraging research, innovation and creativity.
- iii) The faculty shall be motivated to send proposals for research projects to funding agencies like DST, and suitable incentives shall be given.
- iv) The faculty may be allowed to participate in different courses offered by IITs and other Institutions of National repute under continuous education programmes.
- v) The faculty shall be encouraged to participate in Faculty Development Programmes.
- vi) Students shall have an exposure to new Industry related subjects.
- vii) The students can be taught one foreign language like Spanish/French/Chinese/Japanese/German in addition to English.
- viii) Number of student volunteers in NSS activities shall be increased.
- ix) Freshers' Day shall be celebrated within one week from the last date of admission.
