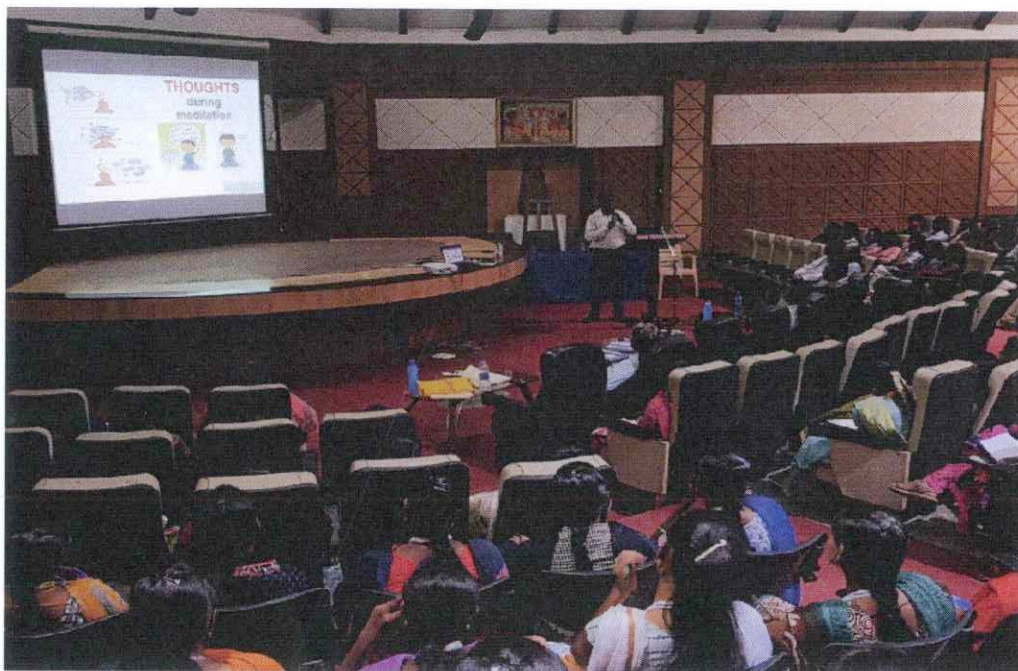
International Yoga Day

The Technical talk concluded with a Vote of Thanks. After the session participants interacted with the Chief Guest on the prospects of research during High Tea.

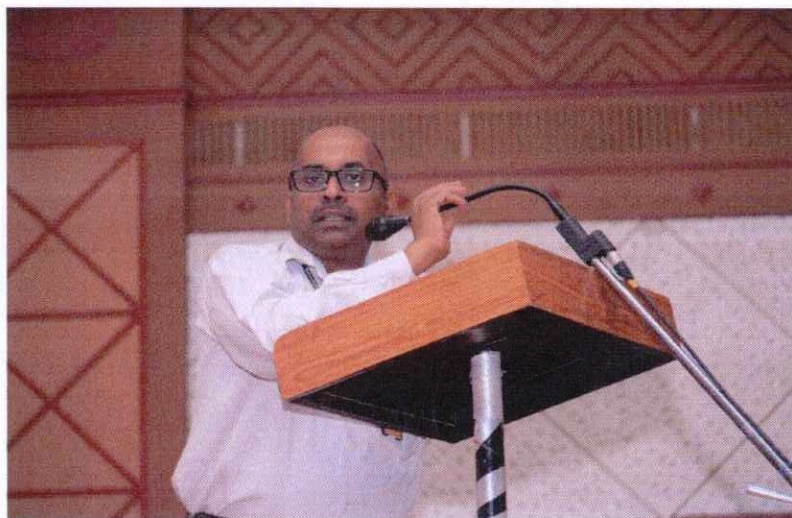

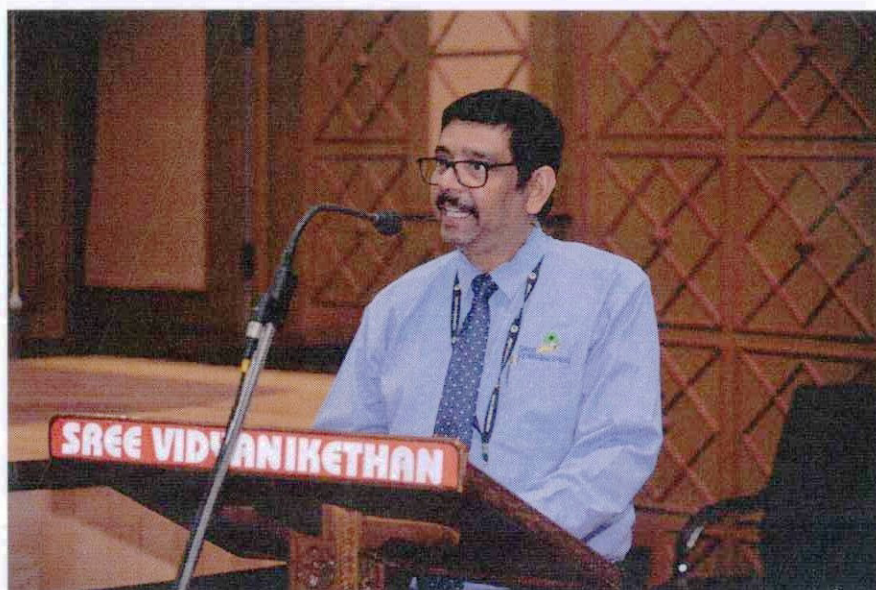
