

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
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National Technology Day 11th May 2019

At SVEC, National Technology Day is celebrated every year on 11^{th} May. On 11^{th} May 2019 the Principal of SVEC presided over the function and spoke on the significance of the day.

Dr. P. C. Krishnamachary, Principal, Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College highlighted that it is the day India successfully tested nuclear bombs in Pokhran on May 11, 1998. India successfully test-fired its Shakti-1 nuclear missile in operation called Pokhran-II, also codenamed as Operation Shakti. The nuclear missile was tested at the Indian Army's Pokhran Test Range in Rajasthan. This was the second test which was conducted after Pokhran-I codenamed Operation Smiling Buddha, in May 1974. He further added that on the same day, India performed a successful test firing of the Trishul Missile (surface to air short range missile) and had test flown the first indigenous aircraft – 'Hansa – 3'.

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



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70th Republic Day Celebrations – 2019 (26th January, 2019)




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National Voters Day

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
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National Youth Day 11th January 2019

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
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National Cancer Awareness Day 07th November 2018
