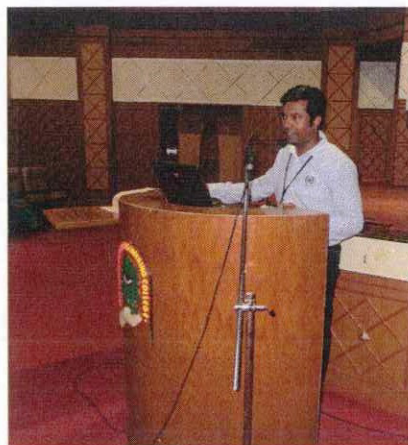

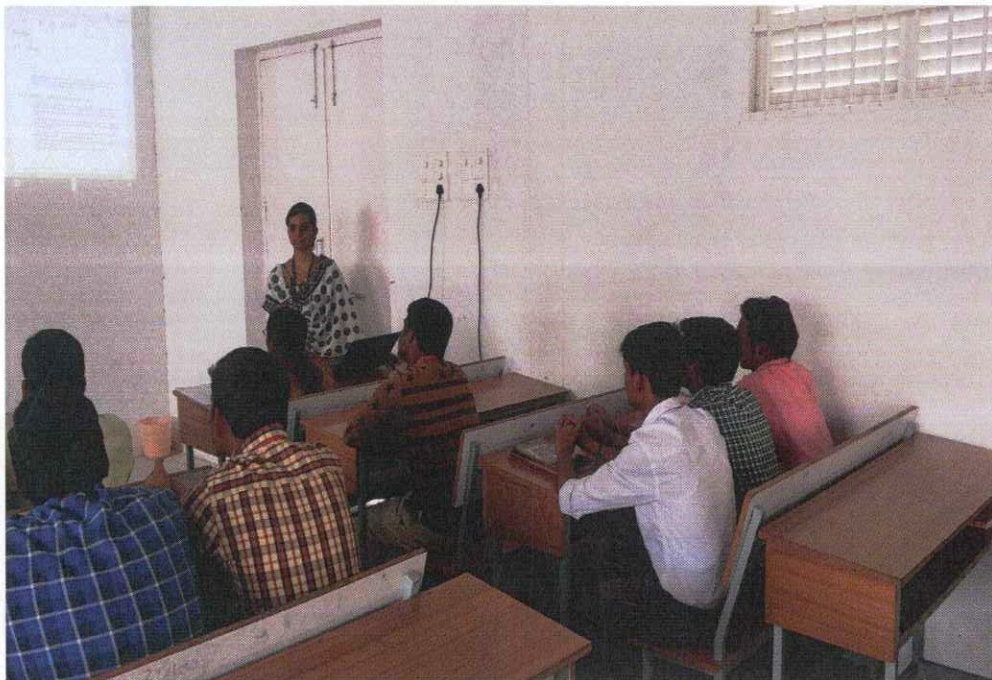

She addressed about value education, basic guidelines for value education, need for value education etc.

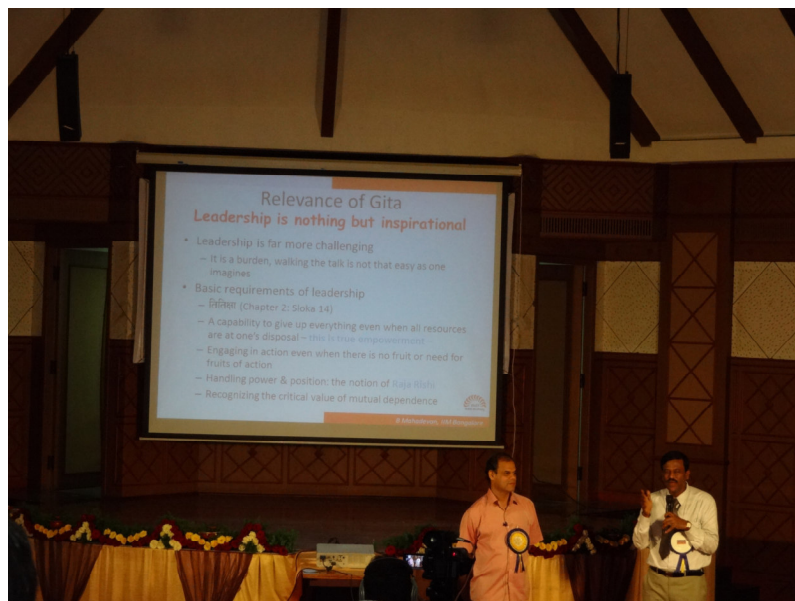

Management Lessons from Bhagavad Gita**

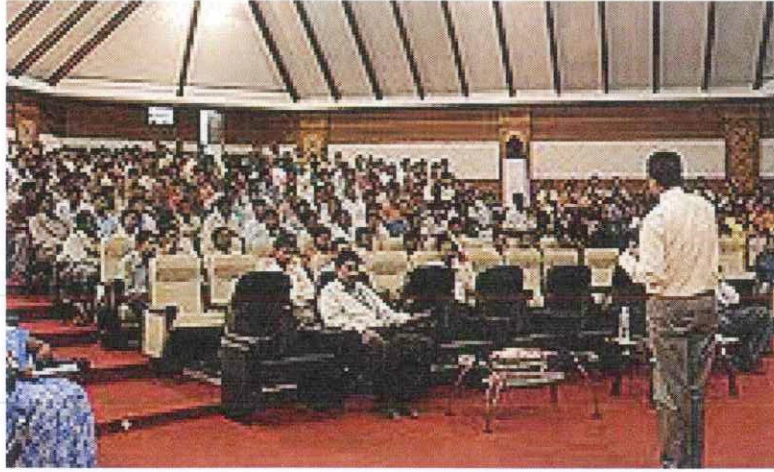

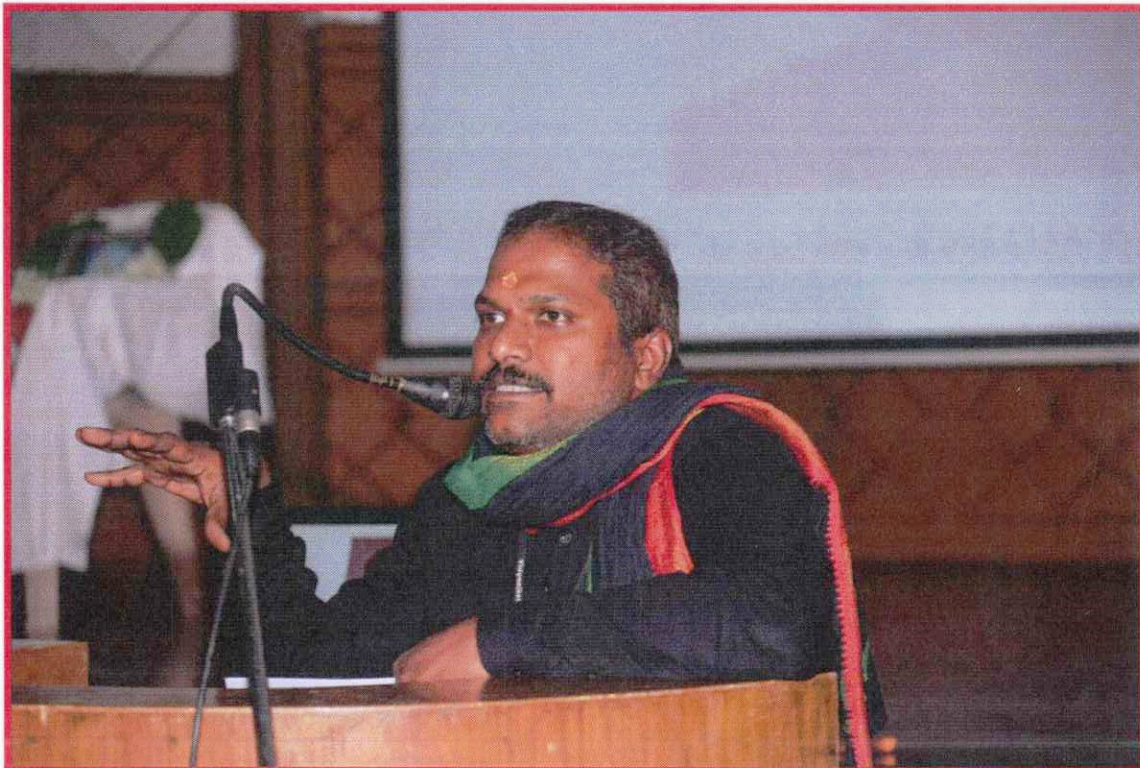
