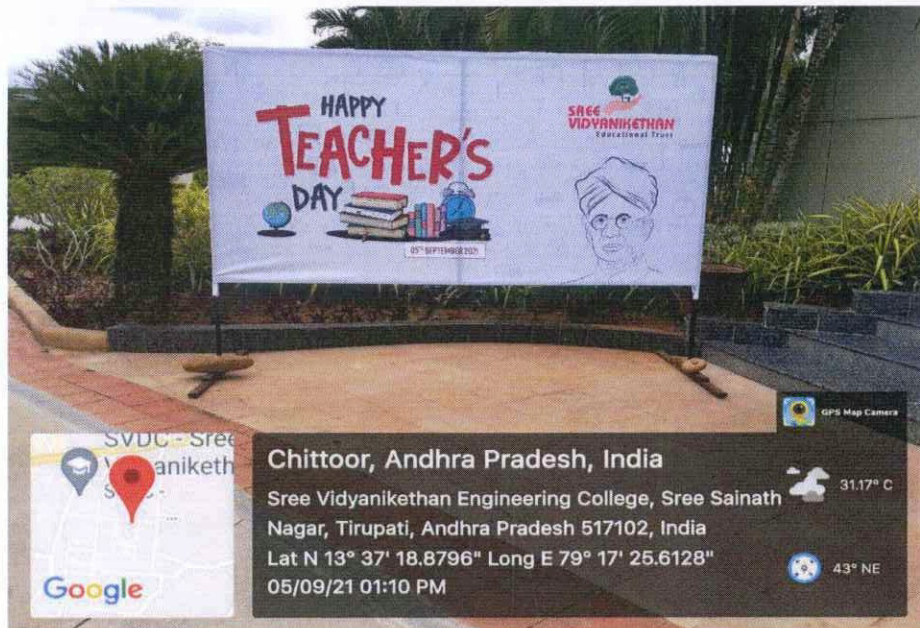

### CORPORATE ETHICS FOR COMPUTER SCIENCE ENGINEERS

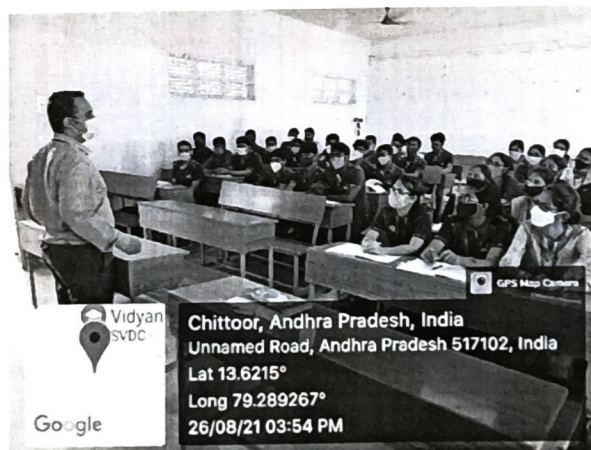

The Department of Master of Computer Applications (M.C.A) of Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College organized a Lecture on **“Effect of Work Life Balance on Accounting Ethics”** on 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 for MCA students.

The resource person was **Dr. V. R. Anitha**, Professor, Department of ECE, Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College. The resource person enlightened the students on the concept of work life balance. She introduced that the concept of Work life balance started at 1930s and progressively enormous improvements took place in the industry along with increase in global competition, and changes in the structure of workforce.

Dr. Anitha also deliberated the positive correlation between work life balance and motivation at work. She focused on the concept of *“When the employees have more work life balance then they can fulfill their responsibilities in both work and family”*. Also, she presented how other employees and accountants have been facing various challenges. The decision making of the accountants however may be affected by various external factors. These decisions are important for many stakeholders of the company. Moreover, the decisions may be triggered by some unethical factors.

Dr. Anitha also highlighted that unethical behavior might lead to loss of funds by the public investors and even claim that this may lead to systematic deterioration of the system. Therefore, a common understanding of accounting ethics is at least as important as a good auditing infrastructure.

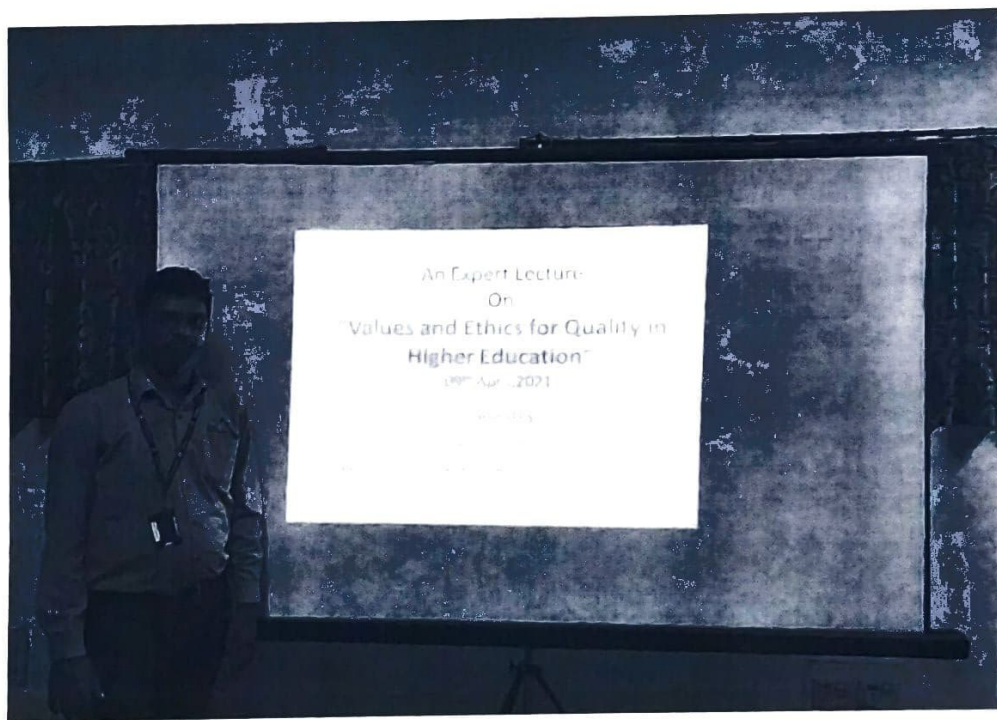

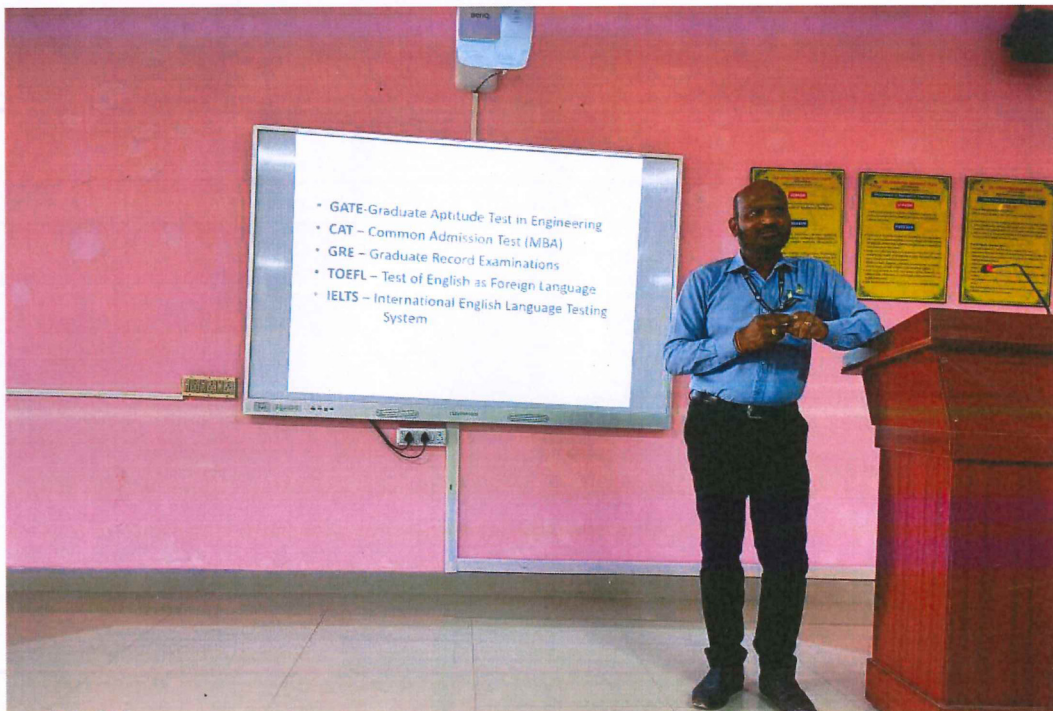


### "Work Ethics for Development Professionals"

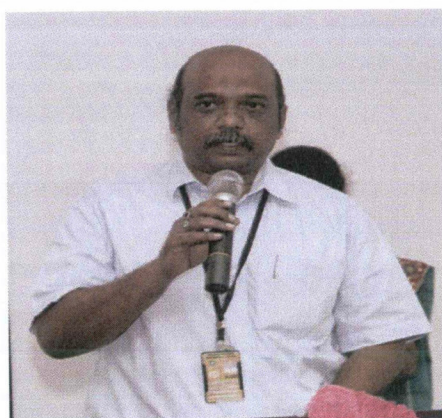
### **Role of Youth in Promoting Communal Harmony**

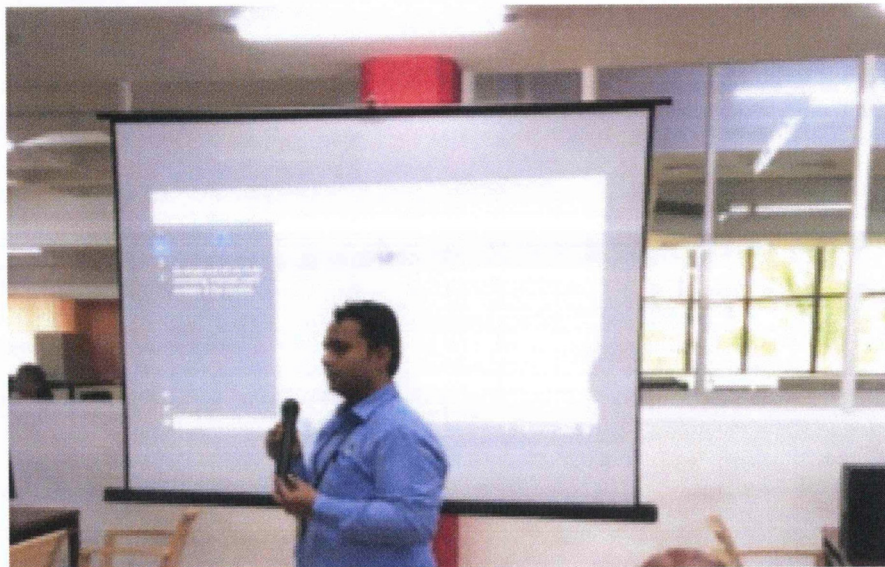

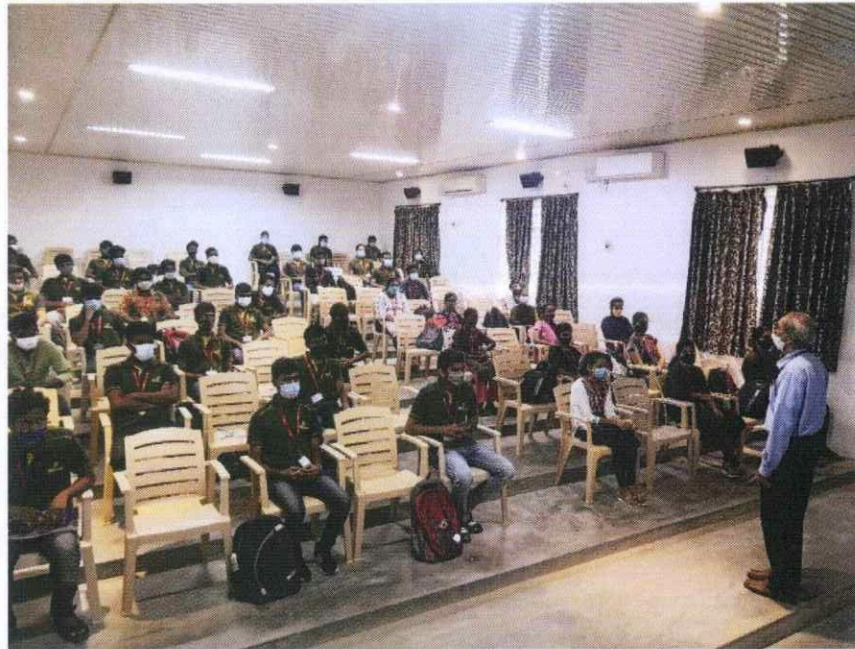
