



# Survey and Health Checkup

#### **Village Visits:**

The team visited all the adopted villages for conducting preliminary village survey in order to identify their needs and to report the same to UBA.2.0.

#### **Details of Visit:**

UBA 2.0 and CRD organized the Village survey programme from 7<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> January 2019. Survey was done by students lead by NSS volunteers team. Around 180 students divided by teams visited villages and conducted survey as per the requirements of UBA 2.0.

Unnat bharat abhiyaan 2.0 in collaboration with, Center for Rural Development of Sree Vidyanikethan Educational Trust organized survey and health checkup programme at **Kotala Panchayat** and **pullaiah garipalli Panchayat** and **allied Habitats**. Students Made a survey regarding facilities available in village, grama panchayat school and health issues faced by the women, children, pregnant and lactating mothers along with the geriatric assessment. Minor ailments were identified and medicines distributed to the needful. The team covered 120 houses in Kotala village and 70 houses in Pandurangaiahgari palli.

During house to house survey, the students performed health assessment which included checking height, weight, BMI, Blood pressure, Blood sugar, Hemoglobin examination, blood grouping to the people.

Principal, Sree Vidyanikethan college of Nursing also visited the camp and gave guidance to the students regarding antenatal assessment and nutritional assessment for under five and women in the reproductive age group.

Students with help of pharmacy graduates conducted Hemoglobin examination & Blood grouping to the all adolescent girls in school and for the antenatal mothers in the camp.

Students demonstrated the ORS preparation, Hand washing techniques and health education given on prevention of vector borne diseases and environmental sanitation and personal hygiene.

# The team identified the common health related problems prevailing in these villages:

- 1. Poor personal hygiene includes wearing dirty clothes, not taking regular bath, poor hand washing practices.
- 2. Osteoarthritis-50
- 3. Hypertension-32
- 4. Diabetes mellitus-18
- 5. Urinary tract infection-7
- 6. Bronchial asthma-4
