14th GRADUATION DAY (2nd August, 2025)

Information to the Students

The **14th Graduation Day** of Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College (Autonomous) will be organized on **2nd August, 2025 (Saturday) at 08.30 AM** on the College premises for **B.Tech** students who have completed their program in **July 2025** respectively. They are advised to confirm their participation in the Graduation Day celebrations and register their names on or before **31st July, 2025**; and **report on 01st August, 2025 at 2.00 PM for rehearsal, which is mandatory.**

They are requested to observe strictly the following instructions:

1. The candidates, who wish to receive their provisional pass certificates in person on the Graduation Day 2025, must compulsorily register.
2. The graduates should complete the online submission for **'No Dues' using their login credentials in NIVA on or before 28th July 2025, which is mandatory.** In case of any difficulty, send an e-mail to nivahelp@vidyanikethan.edu.

4. The registered **candidates should report strictly before 08.30 AM, 2nd August, 2025,** otherwise they will not be allowed to attend the Graduation Day.
5. The graduates who have registered but report after 08.30 AM and those who have not registered can receive the Provisional pass certificates, Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate etc., in the college office after the Graduation Day on obtaining the NO DUES through NIVA.
6. **Candidates are requested to be in their respective seats at the venue by 08.30 AM.**

7. Graduates shall wear the dress representing Indian Culture/Heritage **(White Pant / Shirt for Men; White Half-Saree / White Saree / Salwar Kameez / Pyjama for women)** with shoes.
8. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the Venue after **08.30 AM**. Candidates who are not dressed according to the regulations will not be admitted into the Venue.
9. Candidates are specially requested to take the pledge audibly, after initiation by the Principal.
10. Candidates should remain standing when the Chief Guest and other dignitaries enter the Stage and when they retire from the Venue.
11. Candidates are strictly forbidden from leaving their place until the Chief Guest and other dignitaries leave the Venue after the dissolution of the Graduation Day.
12. Candidates are strictly instructed to observe silence during the proceedings of the Graduation Day.
13. Graduates shall maintain the dignity and decorum during the proceedings of the Graduation Day.
14. Candidates are directed not to bring **Cell Phone/Camera** to the **Venue**.
15. Candidates should carry their proof of identity.
16. Candidates are requested to occupy the seats allotted to them.
17. **Photography:** Two authorized photographers will be available at the venue to cover the proceedings of the Graduation Day and capture the **group photographs of the students of respective departments at the venues decided.**

Also individual photographs of graduates in full academic robe and cap will be captured and framed elegantly then and there itself on a payment basis.
